A Missional Worker...

- Desires to reach a specific group of people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Acts on that desire by starting ministry efforts on a volunteer basis
- Can be anyone from Junior High age on up who is intent on reaching people with Jesus' love
- May gather fellow Middle School, High School, or University Students to study the Word, pray, discuss faith-life, and serve others
- May gather friends, co-workers, and neighbors to pray, study the Word, and serve others
- May start a ministry of prayer and the study of the Scriptures in a nursing home or senior daycare facility
- May spearhead mission or evangelistic outreach to a specific ethnic or cultural group
- May start a creative, outreaching ministry that isn't on this page!
- Will make Jesus' difference in the world!



Missional Worker Training is a 12-month training journey to equip workers for God's Kingdom harvest. After a one-day seminar, each worker will serve in his or her chosen mission field and participate in continuing education for the duration of the year.

The initial one-day training seminar will cover key areas of faith and the application of those areas to outreach and service. Missional Workers will study and discuss:

- **Why Jesus?** – Defending and clarifying faith in Jesus
- **Who is God?** – Understanding God and sharing your faith (the Apostles' Creed)
- **What does it mean to be a Christian?** – Dealing with temptation and issues of integrity, living a life of obedience to Christ (based on the Ten Commandments)
- **How does God reach into your life?** – Understanding and communicating the Word of God; Understanding your mission and the Means of Grace
- **How can you be in touch with God?** – Your prayer life and helping others to pray (based on the Lord's Prayer)
- **How is God leading you to serve?** – Developing your ministry plan and multiplying ministry servants

Follow-up seminars will occur monthly to help each worker grow in the understanding of the Bible, doctrine, leadership development and his or her specific ministry area.

Each Missional Worker will be connected with a local pastor for supervision, mentoring, advice, and accountability.

The training cost for 2010 of \$1200 per student will be funded by the Texas District and other sponsoring organizations—except for a nominal registration and material fee.
